

Golf Course Renovations Update for Members 31/8/17

Quite a bit has been happening on the Course over the last week & I would like to give you an update.

All the Green Renovations have been carried out over the past 3 days

It makes such a difference having our own Machinery & Green's Staff to complete all the Renovations, instead of Contractors.

The Green's this weekend will be slower due to only being cut on Friday & Saturday afternoons, instead of the usual Saturday & Sunday mornings. This is due to the sand on the Green's being wet in the morning & not being able to obtain a clean cut.

Monday week the Green's will be scarified, dusted & over sewn with A4 A1 Blend Bent Grass Seeds.

Tees have also been renovated.

The Fairways have been spiked & amendments added into the soil structure, which will promote better much growth. Once all the Fairways have been cut you will hardly notice the holes in the ground.

The new Diesel Pump was mounted on top of the sandstone platform today & the Discharge Line across the 3rd Fairway, behind the 5th Green & across the 4th Fairway will be completed by week's end.

The Diesel Pump should be operational within a couple of weeks. A few scrubs will be planted around the Diesel Pump to make it less visible.

The Water Fountain for the 11th/12th Dam has been ordered. The old Pump around it will be removed shortly.

All the new nets have been fitted to the Practice Nets.
